

## IT CAN BE DEADLY

Driver inattention caused about 30 percent of all fatal crashes in New Jersey from 2014-2018, resulting in 915 fatalities.

Reading a text for 5 seconds while travelling at 55 mph is like driving the length of a football field blindfolded.

NJ law prohibits the use of cell phones while driving. Fines can range from \$200 to \$800 and up to a 90-day license suspension.

According to the National Safety Council, distracted walking incidents are on the rise. People should stay alert and avoid distractions.
